CLASSES THAT ARE EASIEST TO FULFILL ABROAD ARE:

- Psychological Statistics
- Personality Psychology
- Abnormal Psychology/Counseling
- Social Psychology
- Physiological Psychology
- Sensation & Perception

CLASSES THAT ARE DIFFICULT TO FULFILL ABROAD ARE:

Depending on which school students apply:

- Professional Identity for the Psych Major
- Skills in Psychology
- PSY 280/281 Sequence (Research Methods and Thesis in Psychology)
- Specialty courses and many 300 level courses
- Social Cognition
- Capstone courses (Practicum, Senior Seminars)

FIRST YEAR

The best time to start planning for study abroad is your freshman year.

SECOND YEAR

It is not recommended to start studying abroad until your second semester of your second year.

THIRD/FOURTH YEAR

It is suggested to either study abroad spring of their third year or fall semester of their fourth year. It is best not to interrupt PSY 280/281 or preclude possible graduate school.
